BUSINESS BEAT: Liberation Brewing Comes To Bixby, Merry's Milestone, Dine LBC

Liberation Brewing Company is coming to Bixby Knolls.

The craft brewery recently signed a lease to open shop at 3630 Atlantic Ave., joining the burgeoning beer scene in Long Beach, according to a release from the company.

Liberation Brewing was started by Dan Regan, former member of the popular ska band Reel Big Fish, and award-winning home brewer Eric McLaughlin.

The boys said their Long Beach plans include producing different types of beer to be sold to local restaurants and to customers through an on-site tasting room. Customers also will be able to take brews home in growlers.

They said the brewery would be open sometime later this year.

Merry's Milestone

Entrepreneur Merry Colvin believes she has been making Long Beach a better place for the past decade through the wares she sells at Merry's.

"I want to help world peace along by introducing people to other cultures," the Bluff Heights business owner said. "I think that once we understand each other, we can stop killing each other."

Colvin, who has a background in fashion and politics, opened Merry's

in 2006, giving the store an Eastern bazaar-style atmosphere. The store — which locals easily recognize by the large metal camel sculpture that sits outside — specializes in fair trade, sweatshop-free fashions, accessories and collectibles.

Merry's is celebrating its 10th anniversary this week.

Colvin credits the business's longevity to loyal customers as well as her eye for one-of-a-kind, unique items that cannot be purchased anywhere else in town.

"I opened my dream business based on what I wished for the world," Colvin said. "I didn't realize that Merry's would have staying power for that very reason."
